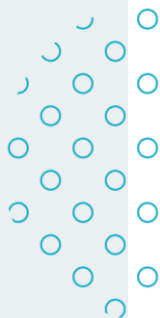

Education for improving human rights situation of people with mental health issues

- **Three groups coming to Oslo, Norway:**
- **Group 1:** The 3rd, 4th and 5th of May consisting of clinicians and direct care workers.
- **Group 2:** The 13th, 14th and 15th of June consisting of clinicians and direct care workers.
- **Group 3:** The 11th, 12th and 13th of October consisting of leaders and managements.

Education for improving human rights situation of people with mental health issues

The program is planned as followed:

- **Day 1: The development and organization of mental health and substance abuse services in Norway focusing on implementing human rights, recovery and voluntary treatment.**
- **Day 2: Visiting the unit of specialized psychiatry at Akershus University Hospital. Meeting with the professionals presenting their work with focusing on voluntary treatment and reducing strain through Open dialogues in network meetings and reflecting processes.**
- **Day 3: Visiting the Medication-Free unit at Akershus University Hospital. Meeting with the professionals presenting their work with patients choosing medication-free treatment.**
