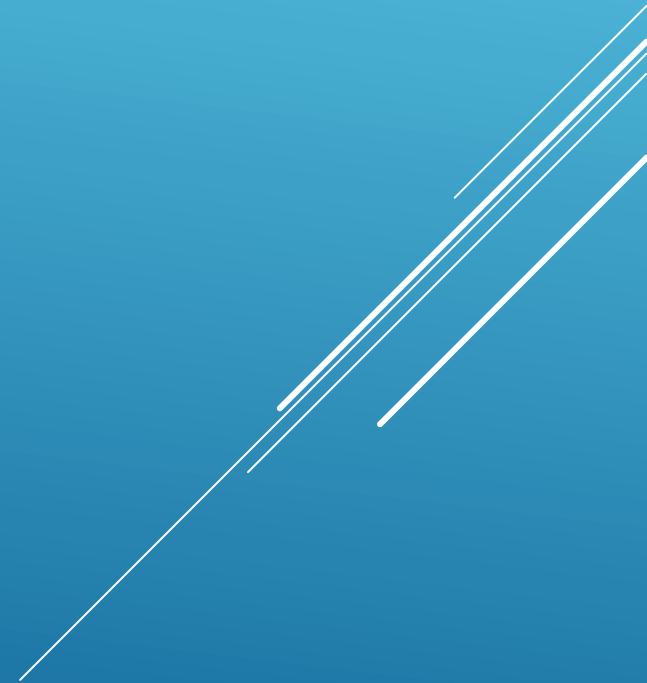

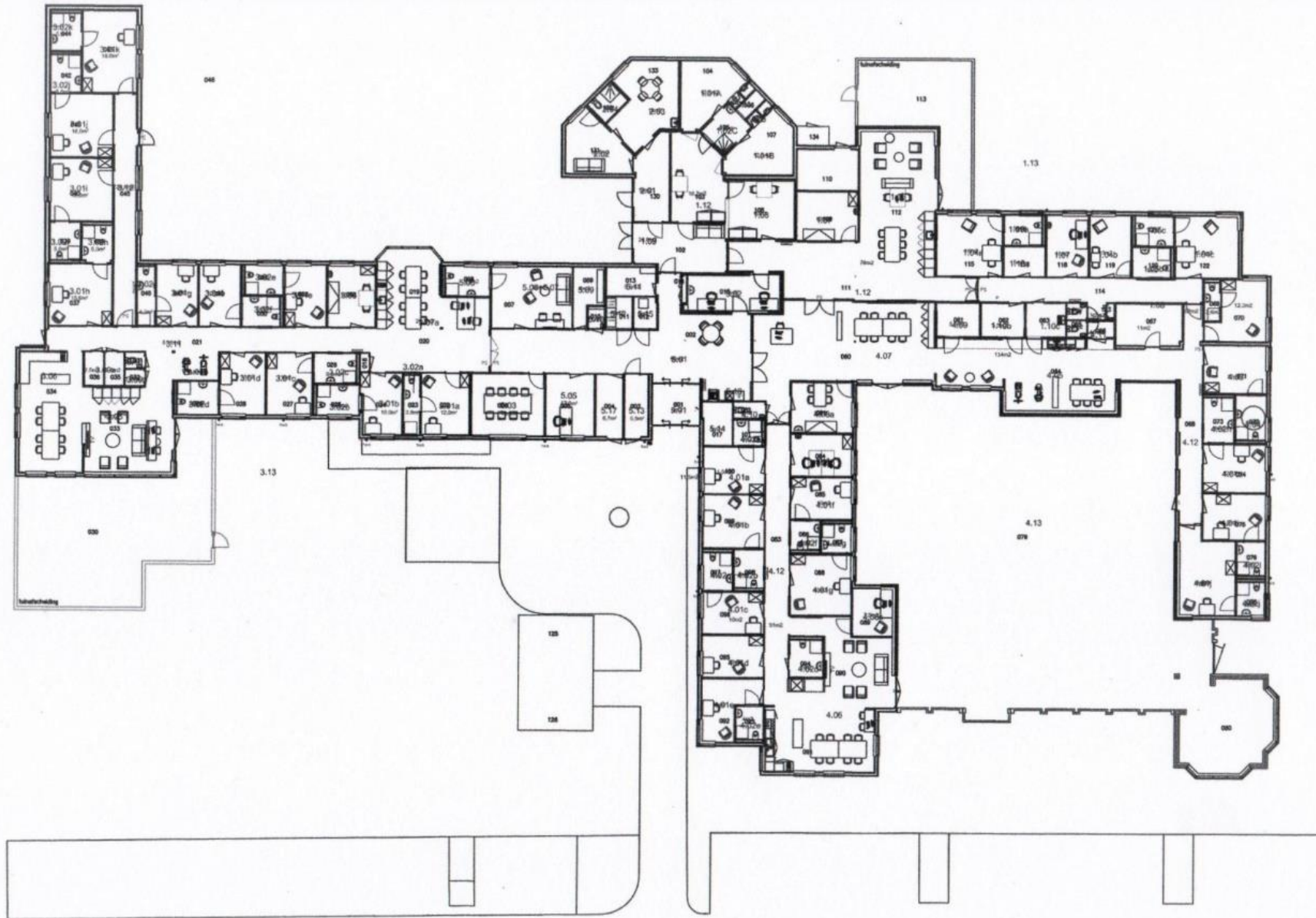

- ▶ 2 Units High Care
- ▶ 1 Unit Intensive Care
- ▶ 2 Extra Secure rooms
- ▶ Total of 23 beds
- ▶ 2 teams
- ▶ One to one guidance possible
- ▶ 8 early shifts, 8 late shifts, 4 nightshifts
- ▶ Based on short term stay. Max. 3 weeks possibility of two times extension
- ▶ Working intensively with family/relatives and outpatients guidance

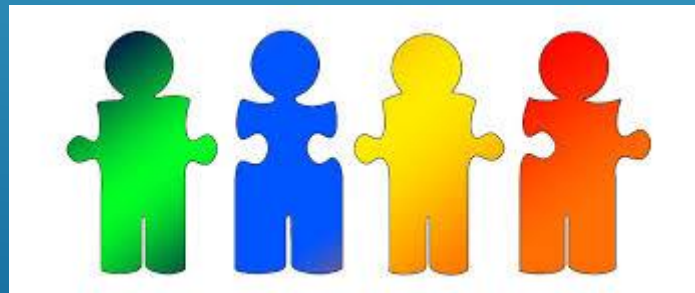
